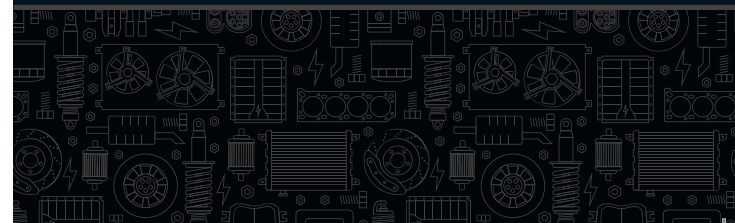

## Comprehensive Coverage

Over the life of Audi Care programs, the following services are performed under the recommended scheduled maintenance.

### Air Cleaner

Clean housing, replace filter element

### Axles

Test for excessive play, inspect all dust seals

### Battery

Test, replace if necessary<sup>7</sup>

### Belts and Tensioners

Inspect condition and replace if necessary<sup>7</sup>

### Brake Fluid

Replace every two years regardless of mileage

### Brake System

Inspect system, check pad wear, check fluid level

### Charging Socket

Clean and inspect (e-tron<sup>®</sup> models only)

### Cloth Top

Check function and rollover protection every two years regardless of mileage (A5/ S5 Cab, R8 Spyder only)

### Continuously Variable Transmission (multitronic<sup>®</sup>)

Change ATF

### Cooling System

Inspect, check fluid level, add if necessary<sup>7</sup>

### Driveshaft Boots

Inspect

### DSG/S tronic<sup>®</sup> Change AT

### Dust and Pollen Filter

Replace every 20,000 miles or 2 years, whichever occurs first

### Engine Compartment

Inspect for leaks

### Engine Oil/Oil Filter

Change oil and replace filter

### Exhaust System

Inspect system

### Lights

Check exterior and interior lights for proper operation

### On-Board Diagnostics

Check (flex-fuel vehicles only)

### Power Steering Fluid

Check, add if necessary<sup>7</sup>

### Road Test

Perform

### Service Reminder Display Reset

### Spark Plugs

See vehicle's Owner's Manual for details

### Tires/Spare

Inspect for wear/damage, adjust pressure if required

### Transmission (Manual or Auto) and Final Drive

Check for leaks and damage

### Underbody

Inspect for damage and leaks, check the wheel liners, underbody paneling and all lines are properly mounted

### Washers (All)

Inspect, check function and add fluid if necessary<sup>7</sup>

### Wiper Blades

Check condition and replace if necessary<sup>7</sup>
